Trip Costs

Students

The cost of this trip will be \$700-\$750, not exceed \$750. We are not able to give you an exact figure at this time because the trip cost is determined by the number of people going (the more students who go, the cheaper it is). Please note that this price includes charter bus transportation, 2 nights in hotel, 2 hotel breakfasts, 2 dinners, performance clinician, studio rental, boat cruise, Observatory admission, Hamilton ticket, Baltimore Symphony ticket, and trip escort. **Money will be collected in installments and is non-refundable as our numbers determine our pricing. After submitting the first payment, you are responsible for all future payments even if you cancel.** Unfortunately, financial assistance is not available for this trip since the trip is optional. Please see table below for fees and deadlines. Students will be responsible for bringing money for souvenirs, incidentals, and 3 lunches designated “on your own” in the itinerary. Students will be housed 4-per room in the hotel and may select their roommates from the band and orchestra (there can be a mix of band and orch students). Chaperones

Directors and chaperones are responsible for student safety on this trip. As a result, this is a work trip for all adults who go, and chaperones are needed to fulfill crucial duties. These duties include but are not limited to taking attendance, serving as bus monitors, being responsible for groups of students, and providing supervision on the bus, in the hotel, and in the city. In exchange for these services, there will be no charge for chaperones except for the 3 lunches designated “on your own” in the itinerary. Chaperones will be housed 2-per room in the hotel. Unfortunately we can only take a certain number of chaperones on the trip, so if too many chaperones are interested, we will select chaperones based on medical expertise, numbers, seniority, equity between band and orchestra, rooming considerations, and other factors.
